# Okinawa Emigrants Descendant & Asian Scholarship


The government of Okinawa has announced a scholarship program for exemplary individuals selected from descendants of Okinawan emigrants and in Asian countries. The international students shall receive education and training at universities, businesses, and institutions for learning traditional arts in Okinawa Prefecture. Students will be provided with opportunities to understand Okinawan history, culture, and customs, gain work experience at local businesses, and promote exchange with local people. The aim of the program is to cultivate human resources capable of serving as a bridge between students' home countries and Okinawa, foster the preservation of the Uchinā Network for the next generation and contribute to international exchange with Okinawa Prefecture. ## LECTURE SERIES - sponsored by the University of Chicago

RETHINKING "REVERSION" Okinawa, Japan, and the U.S. Fifty Years Later

May 15, 2022 will mark the fiftieth anniversary of the "reversion" of Okinawa to Japan. To commemorate the occasion, the Japan Committee at the Center for East Asian Studies has arranged a series of performances and talks that reflect on the ongoing legacies Okinawa's remarkable history, including the continuing presence of massive American military bases in what remains Japan's poorest prefecture, the traumatic memories of the brutal 1945 Battle of Okinawa and the decades of U.S. military occupation that followed, and imperial Japan's annexation of the islands in 1879.

Join us for these events, taking place throughout the 2021-2022 academic year, as we learn about the unique history and cultures of Okinawa, from the traces of the once independent Ryūkyū Kingdom to today's fashionable tourist destination that is at the same time a hotbed of popular discontent.
